Proposition 65

- > Consumer product exposure warning:
 - > "NARNING: This product can expose you to chemicals including [name of one or more chemicals] which are known to the State of California to cause cancer [or birth defects or reproductive harm] For more information go to www.P65Warnings.ca.gov."
 - > "NARNING: Cancer [or birth defects or reproductive harm] www.P65Warnings.ca.gov."



Proposition 65

- > Possible Changes to the short form warning:
 - > MARNING Cancer [or birth defects or reproductive harm] Risk from [Name of one or more chemicals know to cause cancer/birth defects/repro harm] Exposure www.P65Warnings.ca.gov.
- > Limit use of short form label
 - > Total surface area of product label is 5 square inches or less and
 - The package size/shape cannot accommodate long form warning



Proposition 65

- > TVC signed onto a Cal Chamber letter opposing proposed changes
- > Waiting for final state action
- > Won't apply to goods with existing warnings
- Won't become mandatory for 1 year from adoption date



Trade and Supply Chain Issues

- > China 301 duties to remain for the near future
 - > China 301 duties to remain for the near future
 - > Plan on continuing to pay these duties
 - > Ongoing lawsuit over China 301 Tranche 3 and 4 duties
 - Need to file protective case for possible refunds
- > Section 232 duties to remain for the near future
 - > Cover steel and aluminum and some derivative products
 - > Relief likely for EU based products
 - > Will likely remain for non-EU products



Other TVC Issues

- > Other chemical substance issues.
 - Worked with American Chemistry Council to understand proposed Canadian ban of single use plastic items
 - > Joined coalition in opposing listing plastics as toxic substance
 - > EPA final rules on persistent, bio-accumulative and toxic substances
 - > PIP 3:1 plasticizer and flame retardant.
- > UDI on target for roll out in Sept 2022. Get ready
 - Solution > Guidance document relevant to Class I devices scheduled to be released in 2021
